We have now been in business for 20 years!

After 20 years in business, we are now an established company with expanding services and we would like to update you on the services we provide.

For those of you who do not know who we are, Bionomics Environmental, Inc. is an environmental consulting company that performs a broad range of environmental studies and is mainly focused on environmental support (such as NEPA documentation, noise studies, wetland delineations, cultural resource studies and biological assessments) for infrastructure projects. Our clients include state and federal agencies, and private companies.

Updates

Permanent Office - We built and moved into our permanent office in 2007 and have been here for the past seven years. It will comfortably accommodate 15 to 17 full time employees/staff and gives us the flexibility to adjust staff according to the needs of our clients. Bionomics is a very cost effective, flexible organization and has had as many as 50 employees in order to accommodate the temporary project needs of our clients.

Services

We continue expanding our expertise in several areas including: expert witness, environmental assessments, environmental evaluations, acoustic analysis, archaeological/cultural resource studies and wildlife studies.

Wildlife Biology - Bionomics has the capability of performing both pre-construction and post-construction avian and bat surveys (Anabat Systems) for our alternative energy clients, as well as fatal flaw analysis, avian and bat protection plans, eagle conservation plans, and associated permitting. We have performed a myriad of biological assessments including Snake River physa snail studies on the Snake River and both formal and informal consultations with federal agencies.

Alternative Energy - We continue to work in the alternative energy field permitting wind turbine projects in Idaho, Oregon and Wyoming. This includes all aspects of the NEPA process, wildlife biology, and archaeological/historical services.

Data Collection and Mapping Capabilities - We continue to strive to ensure Bionomics has the most up-to-date programs to ensure high quality products for our clients. Most recently, Bionomics upgraded our data collection and mapping capabilities with adding a Trimble Geo XH GPS with a 50 cm post processing accuracy and ArcGIS 10.2. These products allow Bionomics to provide high accuracy data collection and a wide range of mapping capabilities.

Acoustic Analysis – Bionomics continues to provide acoustic analysis for transportation and industrial sectors. In addition, we provide expert witness consultation and testimony. Bionomics has purchased a state of the art Bruel and Kjaer 2250 noise meter to add to our CEL 593 noise meter.

ITD Term Agreement – Bionomics recently renewed its term agreement with the Idaho Transportation Department for environmental service categories including environmental documentation, architectural history/archeological, wetlands, biological, and noise studies.
